From 14th - 18th September 2023 up to 40 teams of intrepid adventurers will take on the ultimate challenge, to take art on tour by travelling through eight countries and completing 1092 miles from Sheffield to Munich in a car worth £1500 or less! 40 teams, 8 countries, 1092 miles.

Each team will be going the distance to help end youth homelessness by supporting Roundabout, your local youth homeless charity.

What's the Process



- · Businesses and individuals are invited to register to take part.
- Rally teams will be made up of a maximum of three people.
- Artists submit designs for car bonnets to choose from.
- Teams purchase a car and choose a bonnet design from our shortlist.
- Artists submit designs for car bonnets for the rally teams to choose from.
- · The bonnets will be exhibited in a prominent location in Sheffield featuring a plaque with your corporate or team branding.
- On 14th September 2023 the teams will meet at a central location and convoy out of the city, beginning their Bangers and Cash journey.
- · Teams check into different locations, earning points by completing challenges en route.
- Once in Munich we will celebrate our achievements at an awards ceremony in the city centre.
- The bonnets will return to Sheffield after the rally to be auctioned off for Roundabout.

The Impact of Bangers and Cash 2018

Wow - the effects and aftermath of Bangers and Cash for Roundabout have been just WOW!!!!

It's been just about a year since the last epic rally ended and it's amazing to think how much has changed for us at Roundabout in the last 12 months. Through the help of Bangers and Cash we've significantly increased our profile and we have been able to help more young people than ever before. Before Bangers and Cash we were supporting 180 young people every day, today we support 250 young people every day and we have given advice, support and housing to over 600 young people in the last 12 months.

We focused our Bangers and Cash fundraising on homelessness prevention. We know that if we can stop young people slipping into homelessness in the first place, it is much easier for them to rebuild and live fulfilling lives without the need for support services like Roundabout long into their futures.

Our Homeless Prevention Service in Sheffield supports young people by providing advice, mediation and homeless education in schools with our ground-breaking Peer Education project. Whilst the drop-in service is there for anyone who needs support and advice, we found that not all vulnerable young people were coming to the drop-in to seek help. Sadly, last year we began to see young people sleeping rough in the centre of Sheffield. In my 13 years at Roundabout I'd never seen this before. We developed a new street outreach team and now have dedicated rapid rehousing workers who actively go out into the community, identify homeless young people who need intensive support and help them to access accommodation and develop their long term living skills. Through their hard work and dedication, we successfully housed every young person that we found. Sheffield is now the only city in England that consistently reports that nobody under 25 sleeps rough and that is in no small part thanks to the funds raised by all the participants in the 2018 rally!







But it's tough, we are finding more and more young people who have had terrible childhoods and have much higher support needs than ever before. It will be a real challenge to keep our streets free from homeless young people in the future...but we are up for that challenge if you are!

By taking part in Bangers and Cash, you will be helping to raise funds to sustain current services and expand Roundabout's prevention work to fulfil our commitment that no young person in the Sheffield City Region should have to experience homelessness.

Case Study

Roundabout has helped me so much for the past 2 years when I was going through the worst time of my life. I had nowhere to go and nobody to turn to, to ask for help.

That's when Roundabout basically saved me, they gave me a place to stay but it wasn't just a roof over my head - they gave me a support system.

I was in such a mess when I first started working with Roundabout, but with the continued help of my workers, I am now like a totally different person. I feel like I owe it all to Roundabout, they got me all the appointments with other agencies that they thought could help me and they came with me to the appointments so I didn't feel nervous about going to meet people I didn't know and helped me to get to appointments if I didn't know where the place was.

I am just so thankful for all the help and support Roundabout has given me.

Team Responsibilities

- Purchasing your car for £1500 or less.
- Ensuring you all have insurance and European breakdown cover.
- Managing potential car breakdown en route and "and reaching Munich as a team" with your bonnet
 - this is part of the challenge after all!
- Funding any modifications on your car and your car service (if you choose to have your car serviced but we would recommend this!)
- Return transportation from Munich to UK.
- Looking after your car at every point of the challenge and post challenge.
- If at any point you wish to scrap your car, you will have to find somewhere en route. We can suggest somewhere in Munich, please remember not to scrap your bonnet.
- Fuel, accommodation, ferry crossing, food and drink for your team.
- We are working with a travel agent who can book accommodation on your behalf?
- Your car engine must be no more than 2ltr unless you have already purchased your vehicle.
- If you have the environmental credentials we can look at hybrid vehicles with sign off from the Bangers and Cash team?

Below you'll find answers to the questions we get asked the most:

Do we have to buy our own car?

Yes you do, we have partnered with a local car dealer where you can purchase you cars at a reduced rate or you can buy from a place of your own choice. You are only able to spend a maximum of £1500 on your car.

Do we have to get our own insurance?

Yes you do, you are responsible for your own insurance as well as break down cover, you need to prove you have both before you participate in the adventure.

Do we have to follow the same route?

We suggest doing so, however, as long as you reach the check points and check in via the WhatsApp Group you can take whatever route you like. We will be convoying into Munich on the last day.

Once I have my car can I improve it?

Yes you can, we would recommend that you have a mechanic look at the car before you embark on the adventure to ensure it is in good shape. You can also spend as much as you like on improving the car as long as you prove the initial value when purchased was no more than £1500. However, you cannot make modifications to the outside of your car.

Am I responsible for my car if it breaks down?

Yes, it is your responsibility. You must buy European break down cover in the event your car does break down and manage getting your team and bonnet down to Munich! It is part of the challenge after all!

Do I need to organise my own accommodation on route?

Yes you do. As a team you are responsible for planning your trip including accommodation, route, petrol, food and drink and the return journey back to the UK

Can I have my car crushed after the event and fly back to the UK?

Yes you can. The car is your responsibility, we can suggest where to get your car crushed in Munich, however you need to donate the bonnet back to Roundabout for auction.



Why can we only have three people in the car?

It is important to have spare seats in your car in case other teams breakdown and need a lift! Larger cars are permitted but you must ensure that you have spare seats.

How big can my engine be?

To help ofset your carbon footprint we have limited the engine size for your car to be no larger than 2ltr. Unless you have already purchased your team vehicle.

Will we be driving in convoy all the way to Munich?

No, we will be leaving Sheffield together and convoying into Munich as a group.

We will also be participating in team challenges en route but other than that you are able to drive the route at your own pace. The Rally is not a race and we will be leaving at the same time each morning to ensure the support vehicles are where they need to be.

Will there be a support vehicle?

Yes, the support vehicle will follow the same route and check points to Munich. The support team will include a mechanic and members of the team that will assist with any issues that may arise en route, if they are nearby. We cannot guarantee that we can assist you if you breakdown hence why roadside assistance and European breakdown cover is essential.
